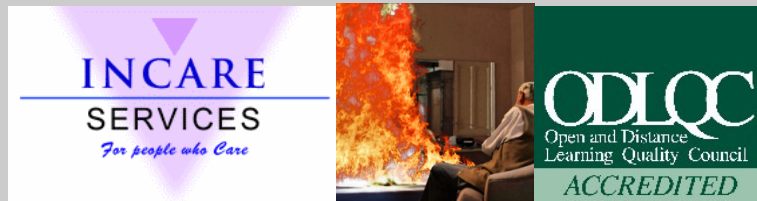


## Evacuation 2
